***Programme for the
Special Session on Unreported Catches***

The objective of this Special Session is to allow for a more detailed exchange of information among the Parties and their relevant jurisdictions on: the methods used to estimate unreported catches; trends in the estimates of unreported catches; the sources of these unreported catches; and the measures being taken to minimise them. The Special Session will be held on the afternoon of Tuesday 5 June from 1400 – 1530hrs and will be chaired by the President, Ken Whelan.
