Application for NGO Status to NASCO by WWF (France)

An application for NGO status has been received from WWF (France), a non-profit association which is working on conservation issues in a number of river systems in France. For example, the 'Plan Loire Grandeur Nature' is focused on Atlantic salmon conservation. WWF (France) is also working in support of the governmental fish restoration programme.

Following consultation with the President it was decided that WWF (France) has objectives that are compatible with those of NASCO and have a legitimate interest in the work of NASCO. They have been advised of, and have accepted, the conditions governing attendance of NGOs at NASCO meetings.
