Election of Officers

1. Rule 10 of the Rules of Procedure of the West Greenland Commission states that “the Commission shall elect from among its members a Chairman and Vice-Chairman, each of whom shall serve for a term of two years and shall be eligible for re-election provided that they do not serve for more than four years in succession in each office. The Chairman and Vice-Chairman shall not be representatives of the same Party.”
2. The present Chairman, Ms Patricia Kurkul (USA), was elected at the Twentieth Annual Meeting in 2003 to serve the remainder of the term of office of her predecessor as Chairman, Mr Rollie Schmitt (USA) (i.e. until 2004). She is, therefore, eligible for re-election. The Vice-Chairman, Ms Julia Barrow (Canada), was elected at the Nineteenth Annual Meeting of the Commission in 2002 and is also, therefore, eligible for re-election.
3. Under Rule 11 of the Rules of Procedure the Chairman and Vice-Chairman shall take office at the conclusion of the meeting at which they have been elected.
