

## **North-East Atlantic Commission**

**NEA(02)3**

### ***Election of Officers***

1. Rule 11 of the Rules of Procedure of the North-East Atlantic Commission states that “the Commission shall elect from among its members a Chairman and Vice-Chairman, each of whom shall serve for a term of two years and shall be eligible for re-election provided that they do not serve for more than four years in succession in each office. The Chairman and Vice-Chairman shall not be representatives of the same Party.”
2. The present Chairman, Mr Vladimir Moskalenko (Russian Federation), and Vice-Chairman, Mr Arni Isaksson (Iceland), were elected at the Fifteenth Annual Meeting of the Commission in 1998 and they are not, therefore, eligible for re-election.
3. Under Rule 12 of the Rules of Procedure the Chairman and Vice-Chairman shall take office at the conclusion of the meeting at which they have been elected.
